Employee Transportation Needs Assessment Study – Pittsburgh Downtown Partnership (July 2003)

- Downtown employee population 140,000
- Average commuting distance is 13 miles
- Commuting times vary from 5 – 10 minutes to more than 45 minutes
- The mean commuting time is 34.18 minutes
- In a normal work week (percentage):

48	commute by bus or T	40.3	drive alone
9	carpool	2.1	walk
.7	vanpool	.4	bicycle
- Average costs for commuting per month:
 - \$103.33 parking (were not asked about fuel or vehicle maintenance)
 - \$63.53 bus/T
 - \$28.01 roadway tolls



Journey to Work: 2000, Census 2000 Brief

- Among the 128.3 million workers in the United States in 2000, 76 percent drove alone to work. In addition, 12 percent carpoled, 4.7 percent used public transportation, 3.3 percent worked at home, 2.9 walked to work...
- Average travel time to work for men = 27.2 minutes and for women = 23.6 minutes
